- Completed Recommendation Form (someone not related to you)
- Resume

Responsibilities

- Summer mentor training attendance required
- 6 hour time commitment per month (Sept. through April)
 - Monthly mentor meetings required
 - Twice a month meetings with 5th graders required
- Engage with/interact with 5th graders at meetings
- Be a positive role model for 5th graders, peer and others
- Avoid risky behaviors
